



NOMINATIONS TO THE ETHICS BOARD

The Association's Ethics Board has nine members:

- The Chairperson of the Ethics Board who is a senior member of the profession (elected by the Council).
- Three senior members of the Association who are not current members of the Council (selected by Council).
- Three members of the Association who are not members of Council; and
- Three community representatives.

The three **member - elected members** of the Ethics Board are selected by ballot every two years at the Annual General Meeting. These members should bring an interest and experience in ethics and knowledge of speech pathology practice.

The next election for the member-elected member positions will be held in 2010. The Association is calling for nominations for current members of the Association who are not members of Council to sit on the Ethics Board. Please consider your own interest in sitting on the Association's Ethics Board and/or if you know of specific colleagues who would be suitable. Current members of the Ethics Board may be nominated for re-election.
