



PSR requirements for New Graduates

Please note: New graduates who upgrade to Practising membership or who join as a Practising member must opt in to PSR by the last working day of February or wait until the following renewal year to opt in. This is to ensure that activities are accrued over a twelve month period post-completion of the speech pathology course (as per MRA requirements), with only activities undertaken post-completion being able to be counted towards PSR requirements. Those completing their course from March onwards of any year will need to wait until the following renewal year as a Practising member to opt in to PSR. (For example, those completing their course in time to allow them to join or upgrade as a 2010 Practising member before or on 26 February 2010, can opt in to PSR and will be eligible to use the relevant Certified title and post-nominals in 2011 provided they meet the PSR program's requirements. Those completing their course and then upgrading or joining as a 2010 Practising member after 26 February 2010, will need to wait until the 2011 renewal year to opt in to PSR and will be eligible to use the relevant title and post-nominals as of 2012 provided they meet the program's requirements.)
